The FF1 is intended to be used as an indoor chair. The material can not handle extreme weather conditions and therefore should not be used outdoors. Although FF1 is a sturdy chair, we recommend not exceeding a weight load of 140 kg to ensure the safety of our users.

The felt is easy to maintain due to the dirt repellent nature of the material. If a stain should occur, furniture cleaning foam can be used to remove it. Do not detach the pre-tied parts, as it will be impossible to reassemble the chair.

Assembly instructions



Free FF1 from its box and plastic wrap. Make sure the rope on the side is free of tangles. This will save you some frustration later on.



Next, you are going to bend the upper part upwards and inwards. You should start to see the form of the final product during this phase.



Once you have bent the felt into the right position, it is best to put your knee on the seat. This will prevent the chair from unfolding and frees your hands. Secure this form by putting the rope through the designated holes. Please be aware the collar is on the outside.

Be sure to make strong bond by tightening the rope, knotting and double knotting.



If everything went well, you should see a minimal opening at the back of the chair. You can mold the chair a little with your hands until you are satisfied with the form.
